Absentee Voting:

- A person may vote early, September 20 through October 3, 2022, 8:00am to 12:00 and from 1:00pm to 4:30pm, M-F, Borough Building in Naknek, Assembly Room.
- A person may vote by-mail, request an absentee ballot no later than September 27, 2022, application available on borough's website: bbak.us
- A person with a disability may vote through a personal representative, September 20- October 3, 2022, 8:00am to 12:00pm and from 1:00pm to 4:30pm, M-F, Assembly Room.

If you need language interpretation services, please contact the Borough Clerk at least 24 hours before casting your ballot.

Voter Registration and Qualification:

You must be registered to vote in the State of Alaska and be a resident of the borough thirty (30) days prior to the election. See the Borough Clerk for more information about registering to vote.

Any person may vote in general or special Borough elections who:

- Is qualified to vote in state elections;
- Has been a resident of the borough and the precinct in which the person seeks to vote for at least thirty days immediately preceding the election;
- Is registered to vote in state elections; and
- Is not otherwise disqualified under Article V of the State Constitution.

Boundary Descriptions for Voting Precincts:

The precincts established by the state and set forth in the Alaska Administrative Code shall be the precincts for all borough elections.

King Salmon - Beginning at the intersection of the Bristol Bay Borough boundary and Pauls Creek; then southwesterly along the thread of Pauls Creek to its intersection with the Naknek River; then westerly along the northern shoreline of the Naknek River to a non-visible point south of Fox Court; then southerly crossing Naknek River to the mouth of Chimenchun Creek; then southeasterly along the southern shoreline of Naknek River to the mouth of Smelt Creek; then southwesterly along the thread of Smelt Creek to its intersection with Bristol Bay Borough boundary; then east, north, and west to the point of beginning, including all that area within the community of King Salmon.

Naknek - Beginning at the intersection of the Bristol Bay Borough boundary and Pauls Creek; then southwesterly along the thread of Pauls Creek to its intersection with Naknek River; then westerly along the northern shoreline of Naknek River to its intersection with the median of Naknek River; then westerly along the median of Naknek River to the median of Kvichak Bay; then due west along the median of Kvichak Bay to its intersection with the Bristol Bay Borough boundary; then northeasterly along the Bristol Bay Borough boundary to the point of beginning, including all that area within the community of Naknek.

South Naknek - Beginning at the intersection of the Bristol Bay Borough boundary and Smelt Creek; then northeasterly along the thread of Smelt Creek to its intersection with Naknek River; then northwesterly along the southern shoreline of Naknek River to its median; then westerly along the median of Naknek River to the median of Kvichak Bay; then due west along the median of Kvichak Bay to its intersection with the Bristol Bay Borough boundary; then southeasterly along the Bristol Bay Borough boundary to the point of beginning, including all that area within the community of South Naknek.
